

## Banks County ARES Activation Net

Is the frequency in use?(Let repeater drop)

Hearing nothing, This is KE4IGD operating W4PIC My name is Geof, and I am the Emergency Communications Coordinator (or EC) for Banks County Georgia. I am currently located in the city of Homer, Georgia. I will be your net control station for this Banks ARES net. The purpose of this net is to provide traffic handling and situational awareness for the Banks EMA. (Let repeater drop)

Is K4PIC, KJ4CUJ, KI4BQT on the frequency? (Let repeater drop) Will you take Net or Alternate Net?

Is the Jackson County EC on the frequency? (Let repeater drop) Are you aware of our Activation? We (will / will not) need Mutual Aid support for this Activation.

Is the NEGARC Trustee or NEGARC President on the frequency? (Let repeater drop) Are you aware of our Activation? We request to use the (2m / 440MHz) repeater for this Activation.

Our primary operations net will be held the 147.225 Mhz/+ NE4GA repeater in Commerce Georgia. Please note that this repeater uses a pl tone of 123.0.

Our primary operations net will be held the 441.975 Mhz/+ NE4GA repeater in Commerce Georgia. Please note that this repeater uses a pl tone of 162.2.

Our simplex operations net will be held on 147.525 MHz simplex.

Before I take any other check-ins, Is there any Emergency or Priority traffic? (Handle traffic or acknowledge nothing heard) (If nothing heard) Any Relays? (Handle traffic or acknowledge nothing heard)

When checking in, please slowly state your call sign phonetically, your name, your current location, your affiliations with ARES and your availability for field deployment. Any ARES member wishing to check in - please call W4PIC, net control, now. (Take check-ins)

We will now take general check ins, again - please slowly state your callsign phonetically, your name, your current location, affiliations, if any, with ARES, SkyWarn or RACES and your availability for non-field deployment. Any one, any where - wishing to check in - please call W4PIC, net control, now. (Take check-ins)

I would like to thank everyone for their service during this ARES Activation. I would also like to thank the Northeast Georgia Amateur Radio Club for allowing us the use of the repeater. I would like to thank our Mutual Aid Partners for assisting us. This is W4PIC now closing the Banks ARES Net at local time 24hr format, and returning the (repeater / frequency) back to its' normal operating use.
